

# COVID-19: Where have we been? Where are we headed?

Despite recent declines in COVID-19 case numbers in the U.S., COVID-19 is still a risk in many communities, and public health officials warn about the possibility of future surges as we head into the winter months and holiday season.

This session will provide a review of COVID-19 protections that remain in place for workers in California, including measures employers must continue to take to identify new cases and control outbreaks in the workplace, and resources available to workers who become sick or who must quarantine after exposure.
